LICENSEE AGREES TO CONDUCT THIS TRAINING WITHIN 30 DAYS AND ANNUALLY THEREAFTER.

B. 10CFR 20.1101(C) REQUIRES THAT ANNUAL REVIEWS OF THE RAD PROTECTION PROGRAM BE CONDUCTED. 10CFR 20.2102(d)(2) REQUIRES THAT THESE REVIEWS BE DOCUMENTED AND RETAINED. THE LICENSEE HAS NO RECORDS DOCUMENTING ANNUAL PROGRAM REVIEWS. THE LICENSEE AGREES TO PERFORM THE ANNUAL REVIEW WITHIN 30 DAYS AND ANNUALLY THEREAFTER.
