
I am requesting two changes to item 11.A. on 37-30981-01.



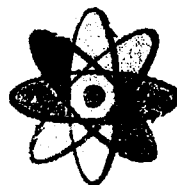
