I just had a loooooooooong conversation with a Mr. John Carollo (Scott, you were so lucky to get his voice mail ...). He says he owns a house near Brattleboro VT and is friends with the town clerk of West Halifax, VT, who tells him there is no EP plan in place to notify residents of an emergency at the plant, or evacuate them, and that the clerk has "only a handful" of KI pills in her bottom desk drawer. He also says the state emerg. mgt. agency does not know of any evacuation plans.

I pointed him to the EP page on the Web site and informed him that NRC gave VT about 93000 KI pills two years ago. I also gave him the # of the SLO in Montpelier. But is there any other way to reassure him that there is indeed a plan? I tried to convince him that maybe he's just not asking the right people, but he's convinced that the plant is out of compliance with our EP regs.
