


The purpose of this modification is to: (1) confirm verbal authorization given on 8/22/2005 to initiate the revised work described within this modification no. 13, (2) extend several deliverable schedules owing to the additional work as well as delays in receiving licensee MSPI PRA data that are input to ISL's analysis and report, (3) provide additional within scope work, (4) increase the contract ceiling amount by \$93,511.00 from \$1,175,687.00 to \$1,269,198.00, (5) increase the contract obligated amount by \$93,511.00 from \$1,175,687.00 to \$1,269,198.00. Accordingly, the contract is hereby modified as follows:

**The following modifications (in bold) are associated with support of the ROP and development of enhanced performance indicators. Efforts conducted under these tasks shall be billed to Job Code Y6370.**

1. Provide a work plan specifically to address the MSPI PRA Quality Task Group recommendation stated above.

Under Section B.3 – “CONSIDERATION AND OBLIGATION-COST PLUS FIXED FEE, (JUN 1988) ALTERNATE 1 (JUN 1991),” paragraphs (a), (c) and (d) are deleted in their entirety and the following paragraphs are substituted in lieu thereof:

- “(a) The total estimated cost to the Government for full performance of this contract is \$1,269,198.00, of which the sum of \$1,186,166.30 represents the estimated reimbursable costs, and of which \$83,031.70 represents the fixed fee.
- (c) The amount currently obligated by the Government with respect to this contract is \$1,269,198.00, of which the sum of \$1,186,166.30 represents the estimated reimbursable costs, and of which \$83,031.70 represents the fixed fee.
- (d) It is estimated that the amount currently allotted will cover the performance through November 30, 2005.
