The subject contract expired on November 8, 1999, and costs as determined by the contracting Officer, and payments to date are as follows:

Total Obligated amount:	\$458,000.00
Total Payments:	\$439,025.21
Total Allowable Costs:	\$437,603.62
Overpayment:	\$ 1,421.59

The remaining balance under this contract is \$18,974.79 of which \$5,586.49 is fee and \$13,388.30 is outstanding funds. The NRC is going to apply \$1,421.59 of the fixed fee to this contract for overpayment. The remaining fee in the amount of \$4,264.90 will be used against NRC Contract No. 33-91-215. In accordance with NRC's letter to DCCA on January 30, 2003 it is possible based on DCAA audit report no. 6141-96G10250005 that DCCA may owe the NRC \$130,592.75 on contract no. NRC-33-91-215. Therefore any remaining fee from other NRC contracts are to be used against NRC-33-91-215. The remaining funds of \$13,388.30 under NRC-33-95-175 will be deobligated.

Therefore, enclosed for your records is one signed copy of Modification No. 13 which incorporates the final indirect costs rates for the periods covering fiscal years 91-92 in accordance with DCAA Audit Report No. 6141-6G10250005 and deobligates excess funds remaining under the contract in the amount of \$18,974.79.

To complete the closeout process of this contract you are also requested to complete and return the enclosed Final Release, General Assignment and certifications forms regarding application of proceeds from refund, rebates, credits and other amounts required by Clause No. 52.216-7 of the contract.

You are reminded that your contract records must be preserved for possible access by the Comptroller general in accordance with the "Examination of Records" clause.


