Withdrawal of License Amendment Request 04-05
Associated With Changes to Spent Fuel Assembly Storage Technical Specifications

FPL Energy Seabrook, LLC hereby withdraws License Amendment Request (LAR) 04-05 submitted by letter SBK-L-05062, dated March 28, 2005. LAR 04-05 proposed changes to the Seabrook Station Technical Specifications for spent fuel storage and new fuel storage. The proposed changes reflected a two-zone spent fuel pool consisting of BORAFLEX[®] and BORAL[®] fuel assembly storage racks, as well as the addition of a new technical specification for spent fuel boron concentration based on a revised criticality analysis to support a two-zone spent fuel pool. Withdrawal of LAR 04-05 is predicated on NRC acceptance review determination that additional information is required. As a result, a new spent fuel pool criticality analysis will be performed to support resubmittal of this LAR. FPL Energy Seabrook, LLC expects to submit a revised License Amendment Request once the analysis is complete.
