Dear Dr. Peck:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 41 renewing your NRC Material License No. 21-12930-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font. Your license has been issued for a ten year term and will not expire until October 31, 2015.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. As certain updates, modifications and deletions have taken place in the license, some re-ordering has resulted. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

Please be advised that if you wish to pursue authorizing more than one Radiation Safety Officer for your license you should follow the guidance provided in NUREG 1556, Vol. 20, Section 4.13 and you should request an exemption to 10 CFR 35.24(b). Please also note that revised Part 35 contains certain flexible provisions for RSO's in 10 CFR 35.24(c) and 35.24(d), which may preclude the need for authorizing more than one Radiation Safety Officer for your license. NUREG 1556, Vol. 20 should have been sent to you already as it was published in December 2000. It is also available on our website at <http://www.nrc.gov>.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). The NRC's document system is accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>. The enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.


You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.

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Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
