PROGRAM SCOPE			
<p>This inspection was performed to follow up on four violations of NRC requirements identified during an inspection on May 25, 2005 under inspection report number 030-35120/2005001. The violations were: 1) failure to specify an RSO on the license (SL III); 2) failure to conduct a physical inventory every 6 months (SL IV); 3) failure to close shutter of gauge while unit was not in operation (SL IV); and 4) failure to post an area near the gauges (SL IV).</p> <p>The inspector reviewed the licensee's corrective actions as submitted to the NRC in response to the issued violations. The inspector noted that the licensee had implemented all corrective actions as stated.</p> <p>During the inspection, the inspector identified that labels on one of the two gauges possessed by the license was illegible; a violation of NRC requirements. The citation is considered a non-cited violation as the licensee had met all conditions of a non-cited violation in accordance with the Enforcement Policy. The non-cited violation and corrective actions are noted on NRC Form 591M Part 1.</p>
