Bill Sherman called this p.m. to say that although he spoke to the PSB Deputy Clerk, Judy Whitney, he was unable to get a clear answer for us. Ms. Whitney suggested that NRC contact the PSB Clerk, Sue Hudson (who is not in this week), either by phone or in writing with our request on how best to communicate with the Board. Bill indicated since it is a holiday week in VT and most school kids are out of school, there are a lot of families out of the office, too. He said the PSB is located directly above the State's office and they could tell by the parking lot that perhaps Chairman Dorkin (possibly the only PSB member in the office today) provided this response for the Deputy Clerk to relay to Bill.

Bill reiterated his thanks to NRC for first going through the State to contact the PSB. He said he/Commissioner O'Brien, the Governor-appointed State Liaison Officer, would be most interested in being kept abreast of our interactions with and response to the PSB.

I can pursue this issue further with the Deputy Clerk on Wednesday morning, 3/21 - please advise.
