Enclosed is Amendment No. 65 amending your NRC Material License No. 21-00182-03 in accordance with your request.


Please note that we have completed our review of your request to release for unrestricted use Building 267A as described in your June 20, 2005, letter. As part of our review we performed an environmental assessment (EA) as required in 10 CFR Part 51. In that EA we concluded that there was a Finding of no Significant Impact (FONSI) with regard to your proposed activities at the above referenced location. Therefore, in accordance with your request we approve for unrestricted release Building 267A, located at 200 Portage Road, Kalamazoo, Michigan.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). The enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.
