Several inaccuracies in AP story:

- 1) "Entergy Nuclear has filed all the necessary documents with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission in its application to boost power by 20 percent at Vermont Yankee." We are still requesting additional information and licensee will provide several supplements.
- 2) "If both parties are admitted there will be a hearing on the issue." It only takes one of the two parties to be admitted for a hearing - not both.
- 3) "Although the federal regulator has approved power increases at 12 other nuclear power stations, Vermont Yankee's is the first to be contested." Not sure if 12 is the number of extended power uprates, however, the article does not make that distinction. Overall there have been about 100 uprates approved.
