The U.S. Army has reviewed the proposed decision of the 2.206 Petition submitted by Mr. James Salsman. We concur with the proposal to deny seven of the eight petition items. We believe this is the correct decision and support the facts as described by the NRC in their analysis. The U.S. Army also concurs with the granting of Petition Summary Item 1, that Licensees within DoD be subject to existing documentation requirements.
