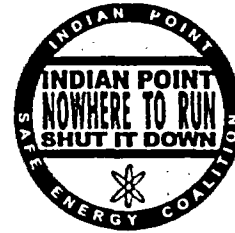

To Whom It May Concern:

My name is Mark Jacobs and I am the spokesperson for the Indian Point Safe Energy Coalition. The special NRC meeting held in Region 1 this week regarding sirens issues for the Indian Point nuclear power plants was not announced to those of us who are on the NRC list to receive documents on topics such as inspections at the plant. This is of great concern, as we are not only stakeholders ourselves, but represent the concerns of tens of thousands of community members.

We were told at this meeting that in order to be sure that we would be receiving all relevant materials related to Indian Point, that we should also request placement on the service list for Indian Points Units 1, 2 and 3. I am officially requesting this as the representative of the Indian Point Safe Energy Coalition, comprised of over 70 groups concerned with the safe operation of Indian Point. I am requesting that I be sent all documents related to all three Indian Point Units,

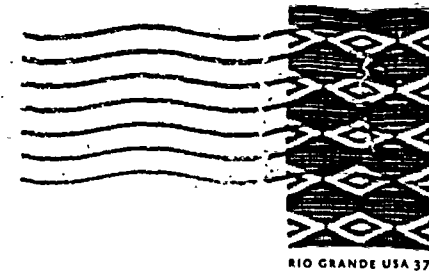
