Subject: Radiological Waste Disposition
Bloomfield, NJ Facility

Dear Mark:

Following per your request is information relative to the disposition of radiological waste removed from the Westinghouse Bloomfield, NJ former Lamp Plant during the 1989-1992 remediation activities at this facility:

The majority of the radiological waste removed during this remediation effort (over 102,000 cubic feet container volume) was disposed of through Scientific Ecology Group, Inc. (SEG) of Oak Ridge, Tennessee. The actual material volume was of the order of 50-70% of the shipping container volume. This material was then processed as appropriate by SEG (compacted, incinerated, or passed through). The resultant product was then shipped to a federal site for burial. The major portion of the material was buried at Barnwell, South Carolina. A small amount of material was buried at Richland, Washington.

In addition to the above, approximately 4,500 cubic feet of mixed radiological/hazardous waste were disposed of by burial at Envirocare of Utah Inc.'s facility at Clive, Utah. 1700 cubic feet of radiological waste (non-hazardous) removed late in the remediation program was also buried at Envirocare's facility in lieu of processing through SEG.
