1. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has found that:
  - A. The amendment application dated September 15, 2004, complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's regulations set forth in 10 CFR Chapter I;
  - B. The North Anna Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation will continue to operate in conformity with the application, as amended, the provisions of the Act, and the rules and regulations of the Commission;
  - C. There is reasonable assurance that (i) the activities authorized by this amendment can be conducted without endangering public health and safety, and (ii) such activities will be conducted in compliance with the Commission's regulations;
  - D. The issuance of the amendment will not be inimical to the common defense and security or to public health and safety; and
  - E. The issuance of this amendment is in accordance with 10 CFR Part 51 of the Commission's regulations and all applicable requirements have been satisfied.
2. Accordingly, based on the foregoing findings, the license is amended by the enclosed changes to Materials License SNM-2507.
3. This license amendment is effective as of the date of its issuance.
