We have received your letter dated November 10, 2005, transmitting the revised Decommissioning Funding Program Description and Depleted Uranium Management Plan for the Paducah and Portsmouth Gaseous Diffusion Plants. Your request has been assigned TAC No. L52568, for Paducah, and L52569, for Portsmouth. Please reference these numbers in any future correspondence concerning this review.

We have completed the initial administrative review of your surety rider and have found it acceptable for formal review. Please note that the technical review may identify other omissions or technical issues that require additional information.

Based on our administrative reviews and projection of current review schedules, we would anticipate completing our review by January 31, 2006. This date could change depending on the findings of our technical review, urgent assignments, or other factors. We will promptly communicate any significant changes to this schedule.

A copy of your correspondence has been forwarded to our License Fee and Accounts Receivable Branch, Office of the Controller, who will contact you separately for billing if your request is subject to full cost recovery.
