SYNOPSIS (OI Case No. 2-2005-009)

This investigation was initiated by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Office of Investigations, Region II, on March 9, 2005, to determine if four contract security Training Instructors employed by the The Wackenhut Corporation (TWC), at the V. C. Summer Nuclear Plant (Summer) willfully falsified Security Qualification Training (SQT) records associated with the instructors' re-qualification process.

Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, the allegation that four Training Instructors willfully falsified their SQT records associated with the instructors' re-qualification process was not substantiated.
