The purpose of this letter is to provide Revision 3 of the BFN Physical Security Plan (PSP). The effective date of the PSP revision was February 10, 2006. This revision primarily includes the incorporation of NRC approved Security Frequently Asked Questions (SFAQs) 05-10, Revision 1 which clarifies only the requirement for readily accessible security equipment for armed responders and security officers.

This response contains Safeguards Information as defined in 10 CFR 73.21. TVA, therefore, requests that the enclosure to this letter be withheld from public disclosure.


