In the "Certificate of Disposition of Materials," dated December 5, 2005, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive material license. The NRC staff has reviewed the information you submitted in the "Certificate of Disposition of Materials" and facsimile letters dated January 31, 2006, and February 1, 2006, and based on its review, has concluded that all radioactive material that required a specific license has been removed from your facility.

Based on these conclusions no further actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number 12-32496-01 is hereby terminated.
