Gentlemen:

The NRC issued the Reference requesting a response to the subject NRC inspection at CPSES. The results of this inspection identified several areas that the NRC concluded did not fully meet the NRC minimum acceptance criteria. The letter requested that TXU Generation Company LP (TXU Power) provide a written response to the enclosed report within 30 days of the date of the report describing specific actions taken or planned to resolve the open issues along with any planned completion dates. It also requested that TXU Power identify whether we agreed or disagreed with the preliminary NRC assessments and any reasons for disagreements.

Subsequent to the receipt of the inspection report, TXU Power, NRC Region IV and NSIR personnel held a video conference at the NRC Region IV office on February 7, 2006 to discuss the inspection findings. Based on the results of that meeting, this transmittal contains the requested information as identified in Enclosure 1 of the Reference and as discussed and agreed upon during the video conference.

TXU Power submits its response to the NRC inspection regarding interim compensatory measures; section B.5.b (Reference).

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Attachment 1 to this transmittal contains a table reiterating the B.5.b item, the NRC's discussion points as supplied by the Resident Inspector from the video conference, the NRC indicated status from the video conference, TXU Power's response to each of the B.5.b items and a comment section for clarification of TXU Power's position for each of the items.

Because this response contains security related information, CPSES requests that this letter be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 and 10 CFR 73.21. Attachment 1 to this response transmittal contains Safeguards Information.

This transmittal contains three new commitments for CPSES Units 1 and 2. Information associated with each item in Attachment 1 is interpreted as individual elements of three broader B.5.b commitments 27344, 27345 and 27346. These commitments have been previously identified to the NRC as those capturing B.5.b requirements and, as such, Attachment 1 information does not constitute new commitments associated with this transmittal except as indicated in Attachment 2.


