**SEQUOYAH NUCLEAR PLANT (SQN) - WITHDRAWAL OF REQUEST FOR
RELIEF ISPT-01 FOR INSERVICE PRESSURE TEST PROGRAM**

Reference: TVA letter to NRC dated January 9, 2006,
