In a letter (CDM:05:007) dated June 6, 2005, Framatome ANP, Richland (FANP) submitted a revised Emergency Plan. This review was assigned TAC No. L31935.

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff review and the inspection on January 23-26, 2006, determined that the revisions meet the provisions of 10 CFR 70.32(i), and that the changes do not decrease the effectiveness of the Emergency Plan. Safety License Condition S-2 will be updated in a future amendment to reflect the current revision.
