I believe that the current release criteria are appropriate. I have been a Nuclear Medicine physician for 27 years. Recently we treated a patient with 203 mCi of I-131 orally for the problem of metastatic thyroid cancer. We had his wife wear a dosimeter for 1 week and it registered 71 mREM.
