Dear Mr. Rima:

By letter dated December 9, 2005, you provided notification to this office requesting a temporary waiver of the 14 day written request and asked for authorization to commence work at the temporary work site starting December 12, 2005. Mr. James L. Montgomery provided verbal authorization on December 9, 2005 to waive the 14 day notification and start work on December 12, 2005. In addition, Mr. Montgomery requested you provide written documentation, describing the work activities and the information required by your license. Thank you for providing this information in your December 9, 2005, letter. License Condition 13 requires at least 14 day written notification prior to initiating activities at each temporary job site, excluding routine packaging or repackaging for purposes of transporting and jobs not requiring a site specific work package, or characterization and/or final surveys where radioactive materials and/or radiation are not likely to be detected. Nonetheless, due to the time-critical nature of the work being performed for the University of Nebraska Agricultural Research and Development Center, Ithaca, Nebraska, the staff accepts and considers your notification as timely.


Please note that this should not be construed as a general waiver of the requirements under your license, as this office expects licensees to be in compliance with all license conditions.
