Dear Mr. Wright,

I have examined the application for license to handle nuclear materials submitted in my name by Alan C. Jones of Eastern Isotope. I have worked closely with Alan on the preparation of this license and am familiar with the contents. I designed this license based on my previous license in the State of Arizona and find my application in its current form to be very similar to that original license. As I understand it the NRC has issued new guidelines pertaining to veterinary nuclear licenses. I am prepared to make any changes that are necessary to bring our license application in to accord with these guidelines.

One of the changes you have requested is in regards to item 13 waste management; I agree with your suggestion to change the wording to "until 10 half-lives have elapsed AND, using the low level survey meter, the contaminated material has been determined to have dropped to background levels."

Item 5 under receipt procedures and survey meter calibration have been changed to meet your request.

Alan Jones is making the changes to the license application and it will be faxed to you to be in your office Monday morning. We appreciate your assistance in speeding the approval of this license because of the delay in getting this application approved.
