

The papers submitted in connection with NIRS/PC's motion for leave to appear in the forthcoming hearing in Hobbs refer to "the fact that the Board may consider issues related to NIRS/PC's contentions during the mandatory portion of the proceeding" (NRC Staff response at 3, Feb. 21, 2006) and to issues including "necessary decommissioning funding levels" and "significantly increased bond amounts."
