Ms. Hess stated she had not contacted NRC HQ, had not sent them this information, had not reviewed this list and compared it to license application to see if it included any new information, and had not requested a license amendment. I called Ms. Hess and told her to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Compare this information w/ what was included in HFA license application of June 2005, if there is any new information (models not included in application) she should amend license to include these new models w/ NRC HQ 2. Review models of watches distributed and ensure HFA has amended license to include all models of watches being distributed. I told her inspectors would use this information to cross reference what HFA is distributing </div> </div>
