Subsequent to our complete license renewal application dated August 25, 2005, license Amendment No. 14 was issued on January 3, 2006. All procedures submitted in the renewal application should supercede previously submitted procedures. The letter dated June 8, 1994, referenced in Condition 19.A, was the submittal of procedures that had subsequently been completely revised and submitted on March 6, 1998 and updated in our August 25, 2005 renewal application. Therefore, we are requesting that reference to the June 8, 1994 letter (Condition 19.A) be deleted from our renewed license, since those procedures have been replaced. Subsequently, License Condition 16 should also be revised to reference our August 25, 2005 (renewal application) letter instead of the June 28, 1994 letter.

Due to personnel reassignments we are also requesting that Condition 11.B be revised to remove Michael Flenniken as the Radiation Safety Officer. Eric Growney will assume the responsibilities of the Radiation Safety Office. Mr. Growney is a Chemical Engineer, with eleven years experience in working with radioactive materials as an employee of Quest TruTec. Among his duties as the QTT Northeast Regional Manager he has been the Assistant RSO and is very familiar with the QTT Radiation Safety Program. Mr. Growney's resume was previously submitted as part of August 25, 2005 renewal application as Assistant RSO. Norman Lanier will continue in his role as Corporate Radiation Safety Officer and as in the past will work closely with Mr. Growney to insure continual regulatory compliance. With the re-assignment of Mr. Growney, Andrew Cummings will be designated as the Assistant Radiation Safety Officer. Mr. Cummings will report to Mr. Growney in the performance of his duties as ARSO.

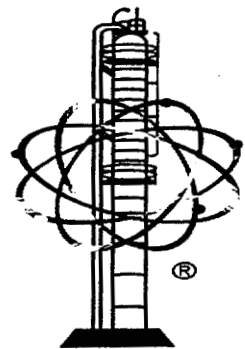

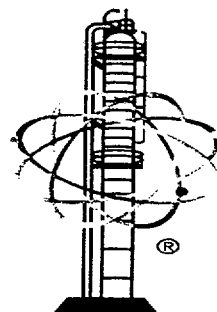
