I am concerned that the current NRC proposal includes no upgrades to existing security requirements for nuclear facilities. 19 attackers were involved in 9/11; how can we not require protection for at least that number? (More would be better.). And on 9/11 we were attacked from the air. Why would reactors not be required to be protected against air attacks?

I believe something along the lines of the "Beamhenge" shields should be implemented (see the Committee to Bridge the Gap Petition for Rulemaking). Furthermore, I am troubled by the administrative process here. Closed meetings with members of the nuclear energy industry, whose goals (e.g., profitability) may conflict with the overarching objective of maximum security for the nation, is a breach of trust on the part of government and is contrary to the democratic principles that distinguish our country from much of the rest of the world.
