Dear Mr. Winters:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 19 to your NRC Material License No. 21-26707-01MD in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. At this time I could not approve Stephen Williams, R.Ph. as an Authorized Nuclear Pharmacist because the information in your letter dated January 6, 2006, and facsimile dated March 10, 2006, was insufficient to complete my review. If you wish to pursue this request please submit a written response addressed to my attention and reference control number 315082. I will continue my review upon receipt of your response.

In my faxed conversation record dated March 7, 2006, I requested you to advise me as to when Stephen Williams completed his didactic training, as the "dates of attendance" column on his forms from Purdue was left blank and I must determine his compliance with 10 CFR 35.59. Your response stated that Mr. Williams' didactic training was completed December 5 -16, 2005, and referred me to an enclosed "Attachment B." Attachment B, however, was unchanged from the original copy that accompanied your letter dated January 6, 2006. The relevant section of the forms should have been revised to incorporate the missing information and an appropriate Purdue representative, such as Mr. Piepenbrink, should have included a signed and currently dated letter supporting this new information.

Please provide this information in an acceptable format, as described above.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). The NRC's document system is accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>. The enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with

NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. *Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.*
