Dear Sirs:

The Technical Specification Task Force (TSTF) submitted Revision 0 of TSTF-475 to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) in a letter dated August 30, 2004. The proposed changes outlined in TSTF-475 Rev. 0 pertain to Control Rod Notch Testing Frequency and SRM Insert Control Rod Actions as currently defined in the Standard Technical Specifications and Bases for General Electric Plants (NUREGs 1433 and 1434).

NRC conducted a review of TSTF-475 Rev. 0 and provided staff requests for additional information (RAIs) to the TSTF in writing on March 12, 2005. Since that date no industry response has been received. During a February 23, 2006 public meeting with the TSTF, the NRC announced its intention to institute a more disciplined review process for TSTFs, including closing out its reviews for TSTFs where no industry responses have been received within 90 days. Consistent with this process, the staff is closing out its review of TSTF-475, Rev. 0 due to lack of industry response. As part of this action NRC will permanently close out TAC MC4441 to all new charges.

In the future, should the TSTF provide an industry response to TSTF-475 comments and RAIs the NRC will open a new, fee-billable TAC for work associated with the review of this information. NRC will also provide TSTF with new target completion dates.
