This memo is to confirm our conversation regarding the referenced amendment. Based on our conversation yesterday, it is Geo-Technology Associates, Inc. (GTA) understanding that the NRC does not require the Frederick storage location to be listed under GTA's current NRC license due to GTA having a current Maryland Department of Environment (MDE) license. Also, GTA understands from our conversation that the Frederick Office is allowed to transport our nuclear moisture-density gauges across the state line into a non-agreement state for use at temporary jobsites.
