Subj: ESTABLISHING PERMIT EXPIRATION DATES

Ladies and Gentlemen:

The Naval Radiation Safety Committee (NRSC) has codified a 5-year renewal periodicity for its permits in the Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) of the Master Materials License, No. 45-23645-01NA. The NRSC has decided to change this periodicity condition in the SOP to align to the NRC guidelines delineated in NUREG 1556 Vol. 20, Guidance About Administrative Licensing Procedures. Specifically, any license issued or renewed after the date of this letter will have a 10-year term limit, unless the NRSC determines, on a case-by-case basis, that a license should be issued for fewer than 10 years. The criteria stated in Appendix C of NUREG 1556 Vol. 20 will be followed to determine license terms of less than 10 years.
