Authorization for Radiation Use

This is to confirm that Dr. Zhou Wang has authorization for possession and use of radioactive materials. He had been authorized since August 1995. Dr Wang registered with the Office for Research Safety, Northwestern University as a principal investigator conducting research with radiotracers. As part of the requirement for the registration he viewed a 30-minute radiation safety video and received the new radiation worker packet, which contains information and guidelines for using radioactive materials.

While at Northwestern university, Zhou Wang worked with radionuclides in a laboratory approved by the Radiation Safety Committee to possess and use millicurie amounts of S-35 ; H-3; P-32; and I-125.
