Braidwood Groundwater Contamination – The licensee continues to suspended all radioactive liquid discharges. The licensee has measured tritium as high as about 250,000 picoCuries per liter in both onsite and offsite monitoring wells and has measured 1,524 picoCuries per liter of tritium in one offsite residential drinking water well, which has been verified by NRC measurements. On Wednesday, January 25, 2006, Chicago media ran front-page reports of the events at the station, and the licensee conducted a media briefing that was also reported. The licensee held follow-up meetings with the State regulators on January 23, 2006, and with nearby residents on January 26, 2006, which Region III attended. Region III plans to complete radiation safety inspection activities in February 2006 and determine any enforcement actions, as appropriate.
