
ECS ILLINOIS, LLC (ECS) has the following response to your notice of violation dated June 2, 2006 in reference to the inspection conducted on May 24, 2006 by the Illinois Emergency Management Agency. During his inspection, the inspector for the State of Illinois observed that ECS had failed to file for reciprocity from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) prior to using licensed material at Naval Station Great Lakes, an area of exclusive Federal jurisdiction.


When ECS transported and used the nuclear gauge at Naval Station Great Lakes, the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) was unaware ECS was required to file for reciprocity prior to transporting the nuclear gauge to the project site. The same day the State of Illinois inspector informed the RSO of this violation, the ECS project manager for Naval Station Great Lakes project was informed that nuclear gauges could not be transported to or used in future site visits to that site.

In the future, the ECS RSO will file for reciprocity a minimum of three (3) days prior to the transportation and/or use of licensed material in an area of exclusive Federal jurisdiction.
