NEVER SAW/HEARD NEWARK MGMT DIRECT OR SUPERVISE A DECISION AT PLANT REGARDING SAFETY/START UP/SHUT DOWN

BELIEVES UNION LEADERSHIP WOULD SAY NOT A BIG CHANGE FOR WORSE IN WORK ENVIRONMENT SINCE 7/02 - CONTRARY TO ALLEGER ASSERTION

NO PLANT MGR FOR LAST 3 YEARS - LED TO "WHOSE IN CHARGE" MENTALITY - MANAGEMENT/DECISION BY COMMITTEE LED TO MUCH INPUT BY INDIVIDUALS WHO HAD NO DECISION AUTHORITY OVER ISSUE

EXCESSIVE - ATTENDEES THOUGHT BLACK AND WHITE/STRAIGHT  
FORWARD THAT NEEDED TO SHUT DOWN TO INSPECT/FIX VALVE

[REDACTED] WAS ONLY ONE WHO KEPT CHALLENGING - DO WE HAVE  
ALL INFO - THOUGHT THAT TYPE OF DISCUSSION COULD BE TAKEN  
WRONG WAY - BUT DOES NOT THINK IT WENT OVER THE LINE

PLAYING OF TAPE -

NOT GOING TO SHARE PERSPECTIVE WITH ANYONE - "GET TO  
RIGHT DECISION - DECISION BELABORED - ' WHY DID HE FEEL  
THAT WAY THEN? "REALLY WASN'T A LOT OF - TIME  
WASN'T LISTENING TO PINTS OF VIEW AT THAT TIME - DOES  
NOT KNOW WHAT HIS MOTIVATIONS WERE AT TIME - CAN'T  
TALK TO PIECE - WENT TO [REDACTED] WASN'T LISTENING"

BUT HE DID TALK TO [REDACTED] ABOUT IT SHORTLY AFTER - ABOUT  
IT AND THE RECIRC ISSUE - ABOUT MIXED MESSAGES BEING  
SENT DOES NOT KNOW FEEL THIS WAY - TALKED TO  
[REDACTED] ABOUT IT - SENT MESSAGE THAT THEY HAD TO  
DEBATE SOMETHING 4-6 HOURS ABOUT A BOLT IN THE  
VALVE - COULD BE PERCEIVED THAT THEY WERE NOT  
BEING FIRM IN DECISION ON HOW THEY WERE OPERATING  
THE PLANT

WE DON'T COME FROM SAFETY - "FRUSTRATION - SAME  
THEME" WON'T SAY IT WAS PRODUCTION OVER  
SAFETY - "I WAS FRUSTRATED - STRUGGLED WITH THE  
DEBATE" AND NEEDED SOMEONE TO VENT HIS  
FRUSTRATIONS TO -AND THAT IS BASIS FOR HIS  
COMMENTS TO HARVIN. DOES NOT FEEL THAT WAY

TODAY. DOES NOT RECALL FELLING THAT WAY ABOUT ANY OTHER ISSUES AT THE PLANT. HAS STRONG FEELINGS ABOUT DOING THE RIGHT THING. ULTIMATELY WE DID RIGHT THING - FRUSTRATION AT TIME ABOUT DEBATING IT FOR SO LONG - IT WAS A VERY EMOTIONAL MEETING AND DECISION

REMEMBERS THAT TIME WAS CHALLENGING EVERYONE. DOES NOT THINK TIME FELT OPS WAS ASKING ALL THE QUESTIONS AND HAD THOUGHT THINGS THRU -

"YOU DON'T UNDERSTAND THE ECONOMICS" - NOT UNCOMMON FOR HIM TO SAY THAT TO HARVIN - TO MAKE HER UNDERSTAND THE GRAVITY OF A SITUATION. DID NOT MEAN ECONOMIC PRESSURE TO KEEP PLANT UP. NEVER BEEN IN MEETING THERE WHERE THAT WAS VERBALIZED.
