


The purpose of this modification is to: 1) Add 13 classes to the schedule for Option Year Four of the contract, thereby modifying Section B, SCHEDULE OF ITEMS AND PRICES to reflect the additional classes and increasing the ceiling amount for OPTION YEAR FOUR by \$34,647.00, from \$58,240.00 to \$92,887.00, 2) Increase the ceiling amount of the contract by \$34,647.00, from \$344,649.25 to \$379,296.25; and 3) Increase the amount funded in the contract by \$34,647.00, from \$280,747.25 to \$315,394.25. Accordingly, the contract is hereby modified:

1. Section B.17, **CONSIDERATION AND OBLIGATION-DELIVERY ORDERS (JUNE 1988)** paragraph a. and b., first sentences, as stated in Modification No. 9, is deleted in their entirety and substituted with the following in lieu thereof:

"a. The total estimated amount of this contract (ceiling) for the products/services ordered, delivered, and accepted under this contract is \$379,296.25."

"b. The amount presently obligated with respect to this contract is \$315,394.25."
