SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF JUNE 21, 2006, MEETING WITH THE PRESSURIZED  
WATER REACTOR OWNERS GROUP (PWROG) TO DISCUSS THE  
GENERAL APPROACH FOR APPLYING INSPECTION  
METHODOLOGIES FOR STEAM GENERATORS (TAC NO. M93912)

On June 21, 2006, a Category 2 public meeting was held between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and representatives of the PWROG at NRC Headquarters, One White Flint North, 11555 Rockville Pike, Rockville, Maryland. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss steam generator (SG) inspection methodologies. A list of attendees is enclosed.

At the meeting, the PWROG discussed its general approach for applying SG inspection methodologies in the tubesheet region at plants with hydraulically expanded tubes. The PWROG also discussed responses to requests for additional information concerning the approach proposed by Seabrook, Byron and Braidwood, and the general approach.
