Dear Mr. Gausewitz:

It has come to our attention that Amendment No. 07 to your NRC License No. 21-15281-02 was unclear concerning the number of devices that your NRC license authorizes. Specifically, amendment No. 07 did not specify how many Troxler gauges and how many Instro Tek Xplorer gauges were authorized. Enclosed is a corrected copy of your NRC license which specifies how many gauges are authorized for each manufacturer.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS).
