The NRC granted an exemption to OPPD on July 19, 2006, to Certificate of Compliance (CoC) 1004 to support loading four 32PT dry shielded canisters for the Standardized NUHOMS® Horizontal Modular Storage System for Irradiated Nuclear Fuel at the Fort Calhoun Station. This exemption provides immediate relief for the spent fuel pool. OPPD would like to discuss long-term options.
