

SYNOPSIS

This investigation was initiated by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Office of Investigations (OI), Region I (RI), on January 8, 2004, to determine whether a [REDACTED] deliberately violated a technical specification required plant procedure and/or NRC regulations on September 22, 2002, by manually closing a valve to isolate a steam leak without the required approval and/or knowledge of the control room staff. -1C

Based upon evidence developed during this investigation, OI found that the [REDACTED] was not a member of the on shift operations crew in the control room on September 22, 2002, when he/she manually closed the valve in question. However, OI did not substantiate that the [REDACTED] willfully violated the technical specification required plant procedure or NRC regulations/ requirements when he/she closed the valve.
