Reasons for Changes in Burden/Responses: The burden hours decreased by 893 hours from 1,883 to 990 as a result of the introduction of the agency's Web-based Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) in 2004 which has made the agency's public documents accessible to all users. For newer documents, Internet accessibility eliminates the need for the public to submit a request to the Public Document Room staff for a copy of a document.

The changes in burden cost reflect an increase in NRC's recoverable fee rate increased from \$154/hr to \$216/hr.
