
This is in reply to your letter of June 8, 2006 concerning the nuclear export license application of XSNM0355. In regard to the nuclear material in this application for Taiwan Power Company, upon verification with the State-owned Enterprise Commission (SEC) of my government's Ministry of Economic Affairs, I am writing to confirm the following assurances:

- a. The transfer of the nuclear material identified in the license application will be subject to all terms and conditions of the agreement for cooperation entered into pursuant to Section 123 of the U. S. Atomic Energy Act, as amended;
- b. The ultimate consignee, Taiwan Power Company, is authorized to receive and possess the material.

I am also informed by the SEC that the export license application of XSNM03551 will be used for the next fuel bid for Taiwan's three existing nuclear power plants. In addition, regarding the amount of nuclear material specified in this application, Cycle 20 through 27 for Maanshan Unit 1 and Cycle 19 through 26 for Maanshan Unit 2 are slightly different from that in the Taiwan Power Company's request for proposal, which was Cycle 20 through 26 for Maanshan Unit 1 and Cycle 19 through 25 for Maanshan Unit 2.

Your assistance in conveying this confirmation would be highly appreciated.
