SUMMARY

On July 31, 2006, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, issued Revision 41 to Certificate of Compliance (CoC) No. 9225 for the Model No. NAC-LWT package. After issuing Revision 41 of the CoC No. 9225, a typographical error was identified in Condition No. 5.(b)(1)(xiv). In the "Parameters" table, the unit of measure for "Minimum active fuel height" was inadvertently left blank. The error has been corrected. Changes made to the enclosed CoC are indicated by vertical lines in the margin.

CONDITIONS

Condition No. 5.(b)(1)(xiv) was revised to fix a typographical error. The unit of measurement, (cm), was added to "Parameters" table next to "Minimum active fuel height."

CONCLUSION

These changes do not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.
