Today we sent the licensee a letter informing them of the results of our SCWE review at Salem/HC. I am sending an allegation status letter simultaneously to the allegor indicating the results of the SCWE review, and providing a copy of the letter to the licensee. [REDACTED] *72* *PA*

[REDACTED] We will use the status letter to close the SCWE issue from an allegation standpoint. Regarding the FOIA question..... we are fairly certain, and are anticipating, that the allegor will make a FOIA request for everything related to the NRC SCWE review. Even though there will be other issues within the same allegation file that remain open, and as such, the allegation file itself remain open, can we be responsive to the allegor, via FOIA, with regard to the SCWE issue?
