SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF July 10-12, 2006, PUBLIC MEETING AND WORKSHOP
ON DRAFT REGULATORY GUIDE (DG-1145), COMBINED LICENSE
(COL) APPLICATIONS FOR NUCLEAR POWER PLANTS
(LIGHT WATER REACTOR EDITION)

On July 10-12, 2006, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff met with approximately 120 combined license (COL) application stakeholders in a public meeting and workshop to discuss the development of the draft regulatory guide (RG), DG-1145, "Combined License Applications for Nuclear Power Plants (LWR Edition)."

During the meeting, the staff discussed specific sections of the RG that have been placed on the NRC web site as work-in-progress documents:

- (1) Section C.I.3.7-C.I.3.13, "Design of Structures, Systems, Components, and Equipment;"
- (2) Section C.I.5, "Reactor Coolant System and Connected Systems;"
- (3) Section C.I.6, "Engineered Safety Features"
- (4) Section C.I.7, "Instrumentation and Controls;"
- (5) Section C.I.8, "Electrical Power;"
- (6) Section C.I.9, "Auxiliary Systems;"
- (7) Section C.I.18, "Human Factors Engineering;"
- (8) Section C.I.19, "Probabilistic Risk Assessment Information and Severe Accidents;"
- (9) Section C.II.2, "ITAAC;"
- (10) Section C.III.1, "Information Needed for a COL Application Referencing a Certified Design;"
- (11) Section C.III.2; "Information Needed for a COL Application Referencing a Certified Design and an Early Site Permit;"
- (12) Section C.III.5 "Design Acceptance Criteria;"
- (13) Section C.IV.2, "Submittal Guidance;" and,
- (14) Part IV, "Miscellaneous Topics;"

The NRC solicited comments and questions throughout the meeting. Questions submitted to the staff on DG-1145 has been posted on the NRC website. It is the staff's intent to develop responses to these questions and compile all the questions received prior to the issuance of DG-1145 for review and comment. The NRC also informed the public that comments can be submitted electronically through the public website until July 21, 2006. The NRC discussed its goal to issue the draft regulatory guide for public comment on September 1, 2006.

Breakout Session: Chapter 17.5 Quality Assurance and 17.6 Maintenance Rule

Sections 17.5, Quality Assurance, and Section 17.6, Maintenance Rule, were discussed in two breakout sessions. The discussion of Section 17.5 related principally to the corresponding Standard Review Plan Section 17.5. The discussion focused on addressing questions regarding the SRP revision and schedule. Comments were offered by members of the industry group, and staff responded to the comments, indicating staff positions and intent to consider reasonable suggestions for improvement. During the discussion of Section 17.6, the industry commented that the section was requesting more information than required for a COL application. The industry gave suggestions for revising Section 17.6. The staff agreed with some of the suggested changes and requested that the industry submit their suggestions in writing, noting the final date for further comments on the draft work-in-progress version of DG-1145 is July 21, 2006.

Additional public meetings will be held in August and September 2006. Future meeting notices will specify the specific topics to be discussed.
