SUBJECT: RADIATION SAFETY OFFICER

Dear Mr. Alldredge:

This refers to information obtained during a partial inspection conducted on May 30 and June 1, 2006, at your facility located in Casper, Wyoming. This inspection conducted by Mr. Bob Brown included an examination of activities under NRC License No. 49-27673-01 as they relate to safety and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your byproduct material license.

Condition 12 of your NRC License No. 49-27673-01, states that the radiation safety officer for this license is Mr. Werner Sandfort. During the inspection, the NRC inspector confirmed that the radiation safety officer authorized under this license, Mr. Werner Sandfort, was no longer employed by JTL Group, Inc. The inspector also noted that Mr. Sandfort, had not been employed by JTL Group, Inc. since April 15, 2006. Therefore, JTL Group, Inc. has operated without an approved radiation safety officer, in violation of your license since April 15, 2006.

In order to resolve this problem, NRC has attempted multiple times to contact you and have been unsuccessful. Mr. Brown has left multiple voice messages on your telephone requesting that you return his call. Please note that it is the responsibility of a licensee to maintain its byproduct material license current. Ensuring that a radiation safety officer is approved by the Commission is a part of that responsibility. The radiation safety officer is a critical position that is necessary in a radiation safety program to ensure the safe use of radioactive materials. It is the responsibility of this individual to assist in ensuring compliance with the conditions of the license and NRC regulations. Additionally, the radiation safety officer is responsible for the total oversight of the radiation safety program and serves as a primary point of contact for the NRC. It is extremely important and necessary that you take steps to resolve the violation of not having an approved radiation safety officer as soon as possible.
