INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.702(a) of the Commission's regulations, the Staff of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (Staff) requests that the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board (Board), designated in the above-captioned proceeding, issue a subpoena, attached hereto, requiring a certain individual, named below, to attend and give testimony at a deposition.

DISCUSSION

The Staff requests the Board to issue a subpoena for Scott A. Coakley in order to ensure the Staff's ability to depose this individual on the date specified. Mr. Coakley is a former Outage Management Manger at Davis-Besse. Mr. Coakley's testimony is relevant to the issues raised by this enforcement action. Mr. Coakley was Outage Manager during the 11th refueling outage at Davis-Besse in 1998, and Outage Director during the 12th refueling outage at Davis-Besse in 2000. Mr. Coakley was identified as a person with relevant information by Mr. Moffitt in his initial disclosures.

CONCLUSION

For the above stated reasons, the Staff requests the Board to issue the attached subpoena to Mr. Coakley.
