
It has come to our attention that there is an error in the referenced application date and Subitem 6. of Amendment 50 to your NRC License Number 24-02490-03. The application date currently reads "December 1, 2006" instead of "December 1, 2005." In addition, Subitem 6. should include the manufacturer, model number and possession limit of licensed material possessed. In reference to a telephone conversation on August 8, 2006, between Wally Fuhrman of your facility and myself, we have corrected your license. Enclosed is a corrected copy of your license showing the changes in the application date and Subitem 6. We apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused you.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.
